• Ozgrav Gather Town is a video chat platform allowing you to move freely between smaller groups of people in a sociable space. This is the map of our space.




How to Join OzGrav Gather. Town?

- Navigate to <u>https://gather.town/invite?token=S6uF3gYeAj1Z6vyWs</u> ubpQ3sKpnIAvG83
- > Enter your full name.
- ➤ You can change the appearance of your avatar as well by clicking the arrows. When you're happy with your character, click on "Next".
- Select your devices such as your camera, microphone, and speaker and then click "Join Gathering"
- Upon entry, you will be loaded into a tutorial on how to use the program. Once the tutorial is over or skipped, you will be in our gather space.





- Whenever your avatar appears in space search for "map" sign (pink screen) in that room. When you become close to the sign it turns to yellow then press "X" button.
- You can interact with interactive objects by pressing "x" button.
- If you like to go to the help desk directly for event information and skip the adventuring, search for "To help desk" sign and stand on the yellow square.





How to Socialize in Gather Town?

- Let everyone know who you are! In the bottom centre of the screen, you will see the following activity bar:
 - 1- Click on your name and the following screen will be appeared. You can add emoji and your current position to your avatar.
 - 2- This icon is mini map of your current position.
 - 3- Share your screen
 - 4- Express an emotion with an emoji



- Let's move around the space!
 - > To get around, use your keyboard arrows to make your avatar walk.
 - Your video and audio automatically connect to others when you get close to them.
 - > On the left side of the screen, a list of participants will appear by pushing the people icon at the bottom left. You can search the participants you'd like to interact with. If you select locate, a direction line will show up, just follow that to reach the desired participant.
 - ➤ There are many colourful circles in the space which are called "private area", it means participants can only see and hear each other when they are in same colour circle. These are great for one-on-one conversations or small group meetings and more.




- > Spotlight areas are indicated by this yellow sign and it means you will be allowed to broadcast your audio, video, and/or screen to everyone in the room.
 - i) When you are spotlighted, your video preview and that of your screen (if you are screensharing) will have an orange spotlight label and will be pinned to the top of the video carousel.





In parallel session, if you want to use spotlight area, you can inform the room facilitator by using your emoji on your activity bar.



We suggest to use "6". When you choose this emoji (hand) it will appear in the left side bar and also on top of your avatar. The other emoji will disappear from screen in few seconds.
